NOTICE OF TERMINATION FROM CCGLA MEMBERSHIP

I am in receipt of your letter dated December 2, 2005 advising that my membership with CCGLA has been terminated, and citing the reason for this action being that I failed to attend the special meeting (resulting in automatic termination of membership).

Firstly, let me state that I continue to believe my rights as a member have been violated by the CCGLA Board of Directors, especially my rights under Bylaws 2.03 (e), (i), (k) and (l). Once again, I am asking that the Board of Directors fulfill their responsibilities and obligations, and adhere to the CCGLA Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws.

In addressing the notice of my termination, under CCGLA Bylaw 2.06 if prior notice is received, *automatic termination* of membership is not an option. Prior notice **was provided** to the board through email (at 4:40 PM), to Morris Garcia, through facsimile (at 5:30 PM), and through a telephone conversation with Mike Agan (at 6:01 PM). During the telephone conversation with Mr. Agan, it was agreed that he would print the letter emailed to the board and provide this to the committee considering my expulsion.


In my letter to the board of December 1, I sought to have the meeting postponed so that I could determine what the specific accusations were that caused this action by individuals of the Board, attempt to address those accusations personally, and exercise my rights under the CCGLA Bylaws. I also provided a number of responses to the claims made in the notice of the special meeting, in the event that the decision was made to proceed with the meeting. I have attached a copy of this letter for your reference.

Given the notice which I received today advising me of the decision of the CCGLA Board of Directors, it would appear that Mr. Agan failed to fulfill his commitment that was provided to me, or the board decided not to accept my letter as written notice. Either way, I am unclear on which of these occurred, as neither of these was noted in your letter.

It appears that the CCGLA Board of Directors has no interest in resolving this matter prior to the lawsuit being heard in the Collin County Justice Court. I believe this to be another decision that does not serve in the best interests of the organization, however given the board's decision, I will defer further communication in this matter until it is presented before the court.
